Anais participated in two world championships. The first one was in the year 2017 and her second participation was in the year 2019.



In 2021, she participated in the Paralympic Games 2020 held in Tokyo. She reached the final and took the 7th place in the long jump event (T37 category) with a performance of 4m07.

In 2022, she won the long jump event with a performance of 4m46 by breaking an African record at the Para-Athletics Grand Prix Dubai.

Her next main target is to qualify and compete at the 2024 Paralympic Games in Paris.
